Parent Pay

With effect from **Monday 1st July**, ParentPay will be the way you order (and pay, if required) for all your child's school meals. All families have been sent their ParentPay activation details via e-mail, but if you need us to reissue this to you, please ask at the school office.
 Using ParentPay will allow us to return to the greater flexibility that was in place before the pre-ordering system, as meals can be chosen **up to 10pm on the night before**. This will mean ordering before 10pm on **Sunday 30th June** for a meal to be served on Monday 1st July. All meals must be selected on the ParentPay app whether or not they are paid for. On Wednesday 3rd July, which is Open Evening between 4pm and 6pm, Mrs Bell, Mrs Fox and Mrs Gates will all be available for a ParentPay surgery for anyone needing any help or advice.



An important reminder - if you have a Squid account with a credit balance, you need to **request a refund** before Friday 28th June – this is done by using the 'help' button on the Squid app.
