Last Thursday, classes 1TM and 1R visited Chesterfield Library to follow the 'George Stephenson - A significant individual' programme. Using a variety of source material including photographs, paintings, artefacts and site visits, the children found out about George Stephenson's life and death in Chesterfield.

Highlights of the day included: visiting Chesterfield Railway Station to see trains arrive and depart from the platform; visiting Chesterfield Museum to find out key facts about Georges' life; walking to a variety of sites in Chesterfield to look at different memorials to George Stephenson and finally visiting Holy Trinity Church to see where he is buried.

The children behaved fantastically well and were a real credit to our school, both on the journey and throughout the day.
