



Bulletin Year 2 September 2026

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Welcome

Hello and welcome to Year 2! We hope you have had a fabulous summer break and are now ready for the new school term. Year 2 is made up of two classes: 2M will be taught by Miss Morris and 2U will be taught by Mrs Upright. Our Year 2 teaching assistants are Mrs Hemstock and Mrs Francis. We work as a team to plan and teach the children. We are really looking forward to the year ahead.

Curriculum

Our topic for this half term is based on Queen Victoria, what it was like to live in Victorian times and holidays in the past. In English, we will be continuing with 'The Curious Quest' which the children also accessed in Year 1. This will be based on a variety of texts beginning with 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne. In maths, we will be focussing on numbers to 100, as well as addition and subtraction. Our science work will cover animals, new life and the needs of humans.

On a Tuesday afternoon the children will be taught by Mr Hinchley and Next Level Sport for music, and PE.

PE

For both classes 2M and 2U the PE days will be Tuesdays and Wednesdays. The Croft active uniform must be adhered to. Either Croft tracksuit or black bottoms and hoodie and a red or white T-shirt.

Earrings should be removed at home on PE days. Tape will be applied to cover earrings if they are not removed, this will be at teacher discretion.

Homework

Similarly to last year, we would like the children to read at least 5 times a week at home to support their reading progression.

Though maths homework is not formally set, children can access Numbots or TT Rockstars from home. This will help the children to develop their recall and fluency of maths calculations.

Login details will be available at the back of your child's reading diary next week.

Communication

Class Dojo

Dojo is a wonderful tool and is still the best way to communicate with the class teacher. We use it to send out lots of information and share the children's achievements. Please also share any achievements or special moments from home on Dojo too. It is lovely for the children to share what they have been doing.

If you have information of an urgent nature or to report absences, please call the school

office, as we don't always pick up messages in teaching hours.

Finally, please remind your child to bring their reading diary and books to school each day. A water bottle is also really important to keep hydrated and aid learning. Also, please ensure all uniform is clearly labelled - this particularly helps us at the end of the school day.
